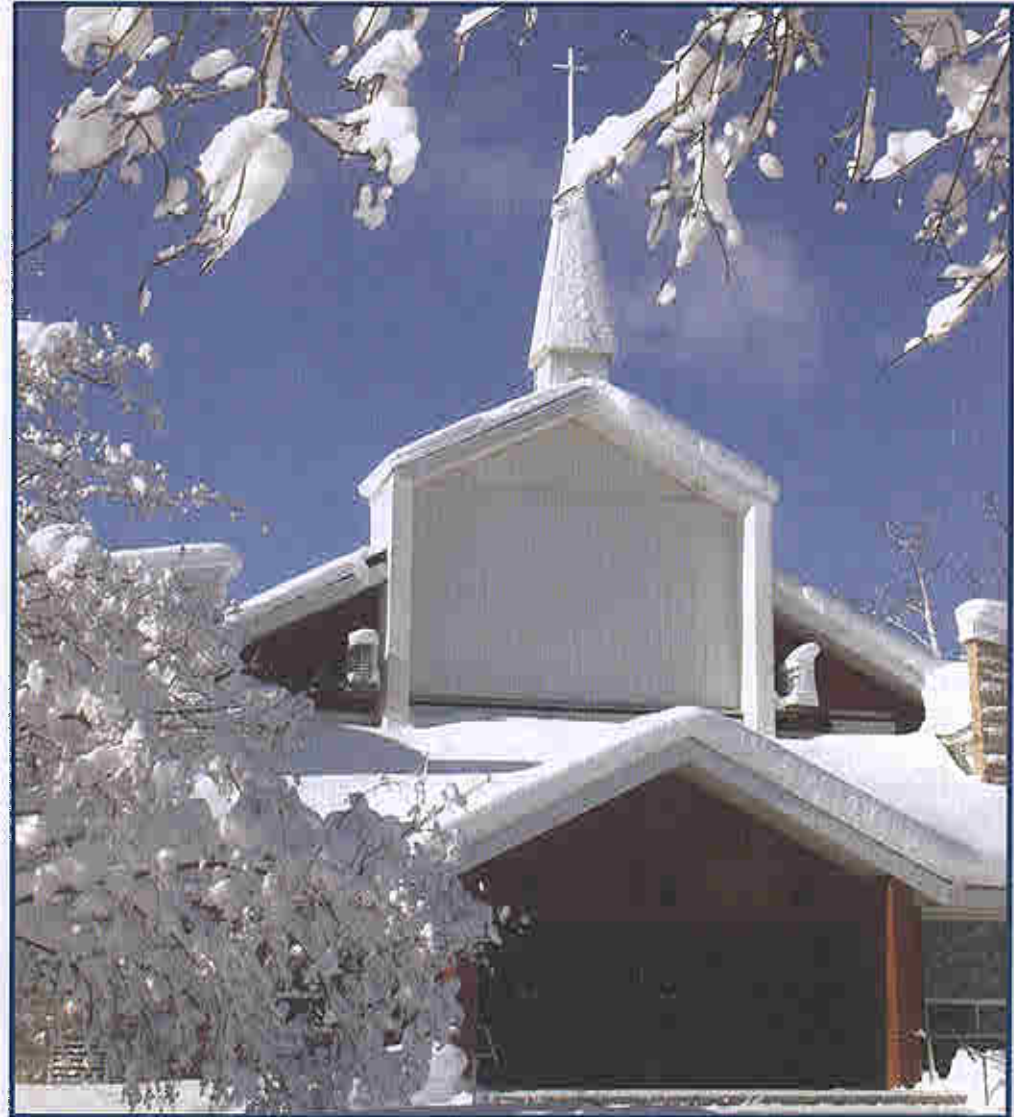
Here is a simple prayer that you can pray from your heart:
